- A board of community volunteers from across the region with 2 resident leaders coordinating.
- The Board, along with a fire wise coordinator, creates a 3-year action plan of goals to follow.
- Based on community need, the Board does research, prioritizes projects, and applies for grants.
- Participants complete educational and fire risk reduction actions as laid out in the action plan.
- Participants turn in time and expense logs of house and property fire hardening efforts in Oct.
